### EXECUTIVE COUNCIL MEETING — MAY 20, 2019

**Meeting.** The Executive Council met on Monday, May 20, 2019. The following are highlighted agenda items approved by the Council:

- The Council approved a request from the Attorney General's Office to retain Ryan Clark of Patterson Law Firm, L.L.P., as outside counsel pursuant to Iowa Code section [13.3\(1\)](#) in *Jason Loving v. Iowa Department of Transportation, State of Iowa, and Second Injury Fund of Iowa*.
- The Council approved a request from the Attorney General's Office for the payment of expenses pursuant to Iowa Code section [7D.10](#) in the amount of approximately \$3,200.
- The Council approved a total of approximately \$141,800 in emergency allocations and reimbursements for the following purposes:
  - \$9,200 to the Department of Public Safety (DPS) to repair vehicle damage caused by wildlife.
  - \$103,200 to the Iowa Communications Network to repair cable damage caused by erosion and a rodent chew.
  - \$8,600 to the Department of Cultural Affairs to repair damage to the Western Historic Trails Center caused by flooding on March 13, 2019.
  - \$16,200 to the Board of Regents — University of Iowa to repair damage to the softball complex caused by a severe storm on August 28, 2018.
  - \$4,600 to the Department of Human Services to repair damage to the Roberts Cottage at the Iowa Juvenile Home in Toledo caused by water leaks on February 2, 2019.
- The Council approved a total of approximately \$24,700 in cost items, including \$12,800 to the DPS to repair vehicle damage caused by a collision with a deer.
