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EXECUTIVE COUNCIL MEETING — JUNE 3, 2019

Meeting. The Executive Council met on Monday, June 3, 2019. The following are highlighted agenda items approved by the Council:

- A personal appearance was made by Recovery Division Administrator Dennis Harper of the Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management to submit a request for funds for Presidential Disaster Declaration DR-4421, and a request for a Contingency Fund Loan for the Muscatine-Louisa County Drainage District #13 to the Council. The Council approved both requests.
- A personal appearance was made by Executive Officer Christie Templeton of the Department of Human Services to submit two requests for disaster relief to the Council under Iowa Code section [29C.20A](#). The Council approved both requests.
 - The first request was for a Resolution of Funds in the amount of \$65,000 in response to the Governor's Proclamation of a State of Disaster Emergency resulting from flood damage in Clinton County.
 - The second request was for a Resolution of Funds in the amount of \$200,000 resulting from the Governor's Proclamation of a State of Disaster Emergency resulting from tornado damage from July 2018 in Lee, Marshall, Polk, and Van Buren counties.
- The Council approved a lease between the Department of Natural Resources and Matteson Marine Service, Inc. for a term beginning May 1, 2019, and ending April 30, 2024, for a parcel in the bed of the Mississippi River with an annual fee of \$10,900.
- The Council approved a total of approximately \$50,800 in emergency allocations for the following purposes:
 - \$20,900 to the Board of Regents — University of Iowa to replace a broken window at the Main Library.
 - \$10,700 to the Iowa Communications Network to repair damage caused to a cable by debris along Interstate 80 in Jasper County.
 - \$19,200 to the Department of Corrections to repair damage to the dietary kitchen caused by a drain backup.
- The Council also approved a total of approximately \$2,700 in cost items.
