EXECUTIVE COUNCIL MEETING — JUNE 17, 2019

Meeting. The Executive Council met on Monday, June 17, 2019. The following are highlighted agenda items approved by the Council:

- A personal appearance was made by Executive Officer Christie Templeton of the Department of Human Services to submit a request for a Resolution of Funds to the Council under Iowa Code section [29C.20B](#), and a second request for a Resolution of Funds under Iowa Code section [29C.20A](#). The Council approved both requests.
 - The first request for a Resolution of Funds was in the amount of \$70,000 pursuant to the Governor's Proclamation of a State of Disaster Emergency in Decatur County.
 - The second request for a Resolution of Funds was in the amount of \$520,000 resulting from the Governor's Proclamation of a State of Disaster Emergency in Appanoose, Cedar, Clinton, Davis, Des Moines, Henry, Iowa, Johnson, Lee, Louisa, Lucas, Marion, Monroe, Pottawattamie, Scott, Union, Van Buren, Wapello, and Wayne counties.
- The Council approved a request from the Attorney General's Office for the payment of expenses pursuant to Iowa Code section [7D.10](#) in the amount of approximately \$3,000.
- The Council approved a request from the Attorney General's Office on behalf of the Department of Revenue to transfer \$40,000 to the Litigation Expense Fund by the beginning of FY 2020.
- The Council approved a request of \$48,000 from Auditor of State Rob Sand, to employ the services of outside Certified Public Accounting firms to perform periodic examinations of cities.
- The Council approved a total of approximately \$1,000 in emergency allocations.
- The Council also approved a total of approximately \$6,000 in cost items.
