TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION MEETING — AUGUST 2019

Meeting. The Transportation Commission met on August 12, 2019, in Ames. The topics on which the Commission acted included:

Administrative Rules. The Department discussed, and the Commission approved, amending [761 IAC 4](#). The proposed rulemaking rescinds subrules considered no longer applicable. The rulemaking also conforms subrule [4.9\(15\)](#) to language in Iowa Code sections [80G.2](#) and [80G.3](#).

Fiscal Year 2020 State Aviation Program. The Department discussed, and the Commission approved, the [FY 2020 State Aviation Program](#).

Revitalize Iowa's Sound Economy (RISE). The Commission awarded a RISE grant of \$1.3 million or up to 50.0% of the city share of the RISE Fund to the city of Des Moines. The project will expand SW 28th Street, located on the southwest side of Des Moines, by approximately 1,600 feet. The project will expand access to the Des Moines International Airport and other industrial purposes. The RISE Program is funded by motor fuel and special fuel excise taxes per Iowa Code chapter [315](#).
