ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION COMMISSION MEETING —AUGUST 2019

Meeting. The Environmental Protection Commission met on August 20, 2019, in Des Moines.

Contracts Amended. The following contract amendments were made:

- A contract amendment of \$308,000 with Stantec Consulting Services. The amendment will provide additional funding for the Floodplain Mapping Program.
- A contract amendment of \$255,000 with the University of Iowa Flood Center for maintenance and revisions of floodplain products.
- A contract amendment of \$447,000 with Original Contracts to continue with floodplain mapping and to distribute preliminary map products to eight counties.

Water Use Permit Fee. The Commission approved a \$95 water use permit fee for FY 2020. The water use permit is purchased by a person or entity that will use more than 25,000 gallons of water in a single day during the year.

Contracts Approved. Two contracts with the Soil Conservation Division in the Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship were approved and included:

- A contract not to exceed \$85,000 for the Shallow Lakes Watershed. The funding will be used to hire a coordinator and for planning purposes.
- A contract not to exceed \$151,000 with the Black Hawk Lake Watershed. The funding will be used to support ongoing watershed projects.

Next Meeting. The next meeting will be held September 17, 2019, in Des Moines.
