EXECUTIVE COUNCIL MEETING — SEPTEMBER 9, 2019

Meeting. The Executive Council met on Monday, September 9, 2019. The following are highlighted agenda items approved by the Council:

- A personal appearance was made by Executive Officer Christie Templeton of the Department of Human Services to submit two requests for Resolution of Funds pursuant to Iowa Code section [29C.20A](#). The first was in the amount of \$75,000 with regard to the Governor's Proclamation of a State of Disaster Emergency for Clinton, Des Moines, Henry, Iowa, Lee, Louisa, Marion, Scott, Wapello, and Wayne counties. The second was in the amount of \$170,000 with regard to the Governor's Proclamation of a State of Disaster Emergency for Lucas, Madison, Marion, Monroe, and Warren counties. The Council approved both requests.
- The Council approved a request from the Attorney General's Office to retain Ryan Clark of Patterson Law Firm, L.L.P., at a rate of \$140 per hour as outside counsel pursuant to Iowa Code section [13.3\(1\)](#) in *Richard Adrian v. University of Iowa, State of Iowa and Second Injury Fund of Iowa*.
- The Council approved a request from the Attorney General's Office for the payment of expenses pursuant to Iowa Code section [7D.10](#) in the amount of approximately \$20,000.
- The Council approved a lease between the Department of Natural Resources and George R. and Mary B. Wandling of Spirit Lake, Iowa, for property located in Dickinson County. The lease shall be for use of a pump house and storage area for an annual fee of \$150.
- The Council approved supplemental and emergency allocations for approximately \$198,000 for the following departments and purposes:
 - A supplemental emergency allocation of approximately \$162,000 to the Department of Corrections to repair a damaged forced main sewer pipe. This will increase the total allocation to approximately \$330,000.
 - An emergency allocation of approximately \$25,000 to the Department of Natural Resources to repair damaged facilities at the Lake Darling State Park in Washington County following heavy rains on May 24, 2019.
 - An emergency allocation of approximately \$7,600 to the Department of Administrative Services to repair a State vehicle damaged by hail.
 - A supplemental emergency allocation of approximately \$3,600 to the Iowa Communications Network to repair a damaged cable in Scott County. This will increase the total allocation to approximately \$27,000.
- The Council also approved a total of approximately \$3,100 in cost items, including approximately \$2,900 to the Department of Administrative Services to repair a State vehicle damaged by hail.
