ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION COMMISSION — DECEMBER 2019

Meeting. The Environmental Protection Commission met on December 17, 2019, in Des Moines.

EASY Air. Ed Tormey, Division Administrator of the Environmental Services Division of the Department of Natural Resources (DNR), updated the Commission on the easy air electronic permit application [system](#).

Legislation. The DNR Director, Kayla Lyon, stated that the Department has no proposed legislation for the 2020 Legislative Session.

Field Services Bureau. Jason Marcel, Field Services Bureau Chief, screened a video presentation of the Bureau and the diverse duties of its six field offices.

Rulemakings. The Commission approved an amendment to Iowa Administrative Code chapter [65](#) changing the definition of “common ownership.”

Clean Water Revolving Fund. Theresa Enright, State Revolving fund Coordinator, presented an update on the Intended Use [Plan](#) after public comment.

Environmental Management System. The Commission received the Environmental Management System (EMS) Annual Report. The EMS program provides an opportunity for solid waste planning areas and permitted facility service areas to employ a framework of responsible environmental management initiatives.

Contracts Approved. The Commission approved the Yellow River Headwaters Water Quality Project. The funding will work to carry out goals of the Yellow River Headwaters Watershed Management plan.

Next Meeting. The next meeting will be January 22, 2020, in Des Moines.
