### EXECUTIVE COUNCIL MEETING — AUGUST 24, 2020

**Meeting.** The Executive Council met on Monday, August 24, 2020. The following agenda items were approved by the Council:

- The Council approved a request from the Attorney General's Office for the payment of expenses pursuant to Iowa Code section [7D.10](#) in the amount of approximately \$4,000 for prosecuting cases under Iowa Code chapter [229A](#).
- The Council approved supplemental and emergency allocations for approximately \$55,000, including allocations for the following departments and purposes:
  - The Department of Public Safety requested emergency allocations for approximately \$9,000 due to vehicle damage by deer on July 4, 2020, and July 12, 2020.
  - The Department of Natural Resources requested an emergency allocation for approximately \$4,000 for repair costs due to high winds causing tree damage at Stone State Park Lodge on June 8, 2020.
  - The Iowa Communications Network requested supplemental emergency allocations for approximately \$14,000 for repair costs related to cable damage due to excessive corrosion in Clinton and Boone counties.
  - The Department of Corrections requested emergency allocations for approximately \$14,000 for repair costs at Newton Correctional Facility due to damage sustained on March 3, 2020, and April 22, 2020.
  - The Department of Administrative Services requested a supplemental emergency allocation in the amount of approximately \$2,000, increasing the total allocation to approximately \$7,000, for Capitol building repair costs due to damage sustained during riots on May 30, 2020. Additionally, the Department of Administrative Services requested an emergency allocation in the amount of approximately \$12,000 for repair costs related to hail damage to a State Patrol vehicle on July 11, 2020.
- The Council also approved approximately \$390,000 for the payment of cost items for the following purposes:
  - The Department of Administrative Services requested approximately \$336,000 for repair costs related to water damage to the Hoover Building due to flooding on June 22, 2020.
  - The Department of Administrative Services requested approximately \$19,000 for repair costs related to storm damage to the Capitol complex on June 22, 2020.
  - The Iowa Communications Network requested approximately \$19,000 for repair costs in Marshall County related to cable damage due to excessive corrosion on January 7, 2020.
  - The Department of Public Safety requested approximately \$5,000 for repair costs due to vehicle damage by a deer on May 13, 2020.
  - Legal fees in the amount of \$5,000 were approved for tribal cases in which the offenses are committed by non-Natives against non-Natives (or without a victim) on the Sac and Fox Indian Settlement in Tama County.
