GOVERNOR'S ECONOMIC RECOVERY ADVISORY BOARD MEETING — SEPTEMBER 3, 2020

Meeting. The Governor's Economic Recovery Advisory Board met on September 3, 2020, by teleconference. The Board was established by [Executive Order 6](#) on June 18, 2020. The Board serves as the central point of coordination for State activities related to the recovery and rebuilding efforts following the COVID-19 pandemic.
