ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION COMMISSION MEETING — SEPTEMBER 2020

September Meeting. The <u>Environmental Protection Commission</u> met electronically on September 15, 2020. Among the topics discussed were the following:

Director Lyon. Director Kayla Lyon discussed the continuing impact of the weather on state parks. For example, remaining tree debris from the August 10 derecho storm could lead to a possible timber sale. Rainfall remains below average for many areas. She also mentioned the launch of the <u>lowa Deer</u> <u>Exchange</u>.

Division Administrator. Ed Tormey commented on the recent Environmental Protection Agencyapproved consent order for the acquisition of the DICO site by the City of Des Moines.

Approved Items. The following items were approved by the Commission:

- FY 2022 Budget Request The Commission approved a \$2.3 million increase from the Rebuild Iowa Infrastructure Fund in FY 2022 for Lake Water Quality improvements, Water Trails/Low Head Dam, and Park Infrastructure improvements.
- Clean Water and Drinking Water State Revolving Fund FY 2021 Intended Use Plan Second Quarter Updates for projects totaling around \$60.0 million.
- Contract with United States Geological Survey The contract from October 1, 2020, to September 30, 2021, not to exceed \$294,000 for assistance in the collection of water flow and water quality concentration data.
