IOWA WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD MEETING — OCTOBER 2020

Board Meeting. The Iowa Workforce Development (IWD) Board met on October 23, 2020, and took the following actions:

Appeals Process. The Board approved the process for a specific appeal from [Southeastern Community College](#) (SCC) in West Burlington. SCC is appealing the decision made by the [Mississippi Valley Workforce Development Board](#) to choose [ResCare Human Services](#) as a provider. An appeal will be heard via the [Department of Inspections and Appeals](#) by an administrative law judge for final consideration and a ruling on an expediated timeline. Either party will then have the option of appealing to the IWD Board for further review. This is the first appeal which has necessitated the creation of an appeals process.

Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Core Program (Titles I, II, III, and IV) Policies. The Board approved the [WIOA](#) Core Program Policies for Local Planning, Reorganization Plan, Characteristics of the One-Stop Delivery System, and Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). IWD worked in conjunction with other Iowa agencies, including [Iowa Vocational Rehabilitation Services](#), [Iowa Department for the Blind](#), and [Iowa Department of Education - Adult Education and Literacy](#) to develop policies for key aspects of the WIOA Program.
