## COVID-19 — IOWA RESTAURANT AND BAR RELIEF GRANT PROGRAM — JANUARY 2021

**Program.** On January 21, 2021, Governor Reynolds and the <u>lowa Economic Development Authority</u> (IEDA) announced the creation of the <u>lowa Restaurant and Bar Relief Grant Program</u>. The Program will provide short-term relief to eligible bars and restaurants economically impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

**Eligibility.** Businesses must be one of the following business types:

- Full-Service Restaurant
- Bar
- Brewery
- Brewpub
- Distillery
- Winery

**Assistance Levels.** The Program may assist eligible businesses that experienced a decrease in gross sales of at least 15.0% during the second and third quarters of 2020, compared to the same time the previous year. Grant award amounts will be determined using a tiered system based on the percent of gross sales loss, with a maximum award of \$25,000.

**Funding.** The State allocated \$40.0 million of federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act (<u>H.R. 748</u>) funds for the Program.
