EXECUTIVE COUNCIL — FEBRUARY 15, 2021

Meeting. The Executive Council met on February 15, 2021. The following are agenda items approved by the Council:

- A personal appearance was made by Christie Templeton of the Department of Human Services to request a transfer in the amount of \$5,000 for the Iowa Disaster Case Management Grant Program (IDCM) pursuant to Iowa Code section [29C.20B](#).
- The Council approved emergency allocations and supplemental emergency allocations totaling approximately \$516,000, for the following departments and purposes:
 - Approximately \$17,000 to the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) for vehicle repairs.
 - Approximately \$48,000 to the Department of Public Safety (DPS) for vehicle repairs.
 - Approximately \$251,000 to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) for repair costs as a result of heavy rains and flooding at multiple wildlife management areas and for damages to a skid loader as a result of an electrical fire.
 - Approximately \$187,000 to the Iowa Communications Network (ICN) for repair costs as a result of cable damage at various locations.
 - Approximately \$13,000 to the Board of Regents – University of Iowa for repair costs as a result of sewer damages.
- Approximately \$13,000 in emergency allocations previously approved for the ICN to relocate a cable was reverted back to the Performance of Duty appropriation after the determination that the project was not needed any longer.
- The Council also approved approximately \$203,000 for payment of cost items for the following purposes:
 - Approximately \$28,000 to the DAS for repairs to a vehicle, the Capitol Complex, and the Ola Babcock Miller Building.
 - Approximately \$30,000 to the DPS for vehicle repairs.
 - Approximately \$52,000 to the ICN for repairs to cables as a result of excessive erosion at various locations.
 - Approximately \$53,000 to the Board of Regents – University of Iowa for repair costs at the College of Pharmacy building due to mercury spills on October 2, 2019, and February 3, 2020.
 - Approximately \$32,000 to the DNR for repair costs due to derecho damage at the Otter Creek Headquarters in Tama County.
 - Approximately \$8,000 to various law firms for legal fees.
