TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION MEETING — MAY 2022

The Transportation Commission met for an informal workshop on May 10, 2022. The Commission discussed the following items:

Administrative Rules. The Commission approved a proposed rulemaking for 761 IAC 634 (Driver Education) to amend the time period in which laboratory instruction may conclude after the completion of classroom instruction.

Revitalize Iowa's Sound Economy (RISE) Fund Applications. The Commission was given recommendations on the approval of a RISE project for Marion County. The Commission approved the project.

2022 Long Range Transportation Plan. The Commission approved the plan lowa in Motion 2050, which is intended to make changes to the lowa transportation system that will be the most suitable for the future. More information on lowa in Motion 2050 is provided by the Department of Transportation.

A draft of the FY 2023-FY 2027 Transportation Improvement Program was presented to the commission for informational purposes. The draft plan includes investments in aviation, public transit, railroads, trails, and highways. The draft includes a total of \$4.2 billion to fund highway and bridge projects from State and federal funds. Of the total amount included in the draft, \$3.3 billion is allocated for safety improvements and conditions on highways and bridges. The draft also includes \$1.3 billion for bridge investments.
