DASHBOARD: ROAD USE TAX FUNDING BY LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT

The Fiscal Services Division of the Legislative Services Agency has recently published an interactive Tableau dashboard that displays distributions from the Road Use Tax Fund (RUTF) to Iowa cities and counties. The dashboard is available at: www.legis.iowa.gov/publications/roadusetaxfund.

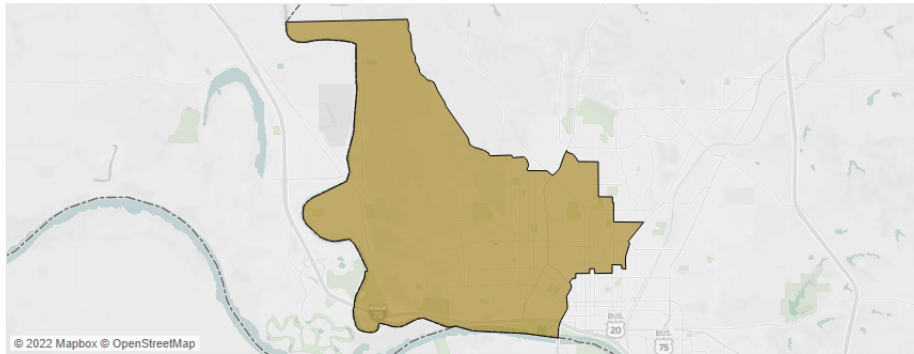
The dashboard has a history of payments from the City Street Fund and Secondary Road Fund from 2005 to present. These funds receive 20.0% and 24.5% of RUTF moneys, after certain distributions, per Iowa Code section [312.2](#). The dashboard will allow users to view payments received within a legislative district by cities or counties. Payments to cities are determined based on population. Payments to counties are determined by a formula that considers rural population, road surface type, travel, and total size.

City Street Fund Distributions by Legislative District

\$340.1 million in statewide City Street Fund distributions for FY 22.

\$11.5 million in City Street Fund distributions for FY 22 to **House 1**.

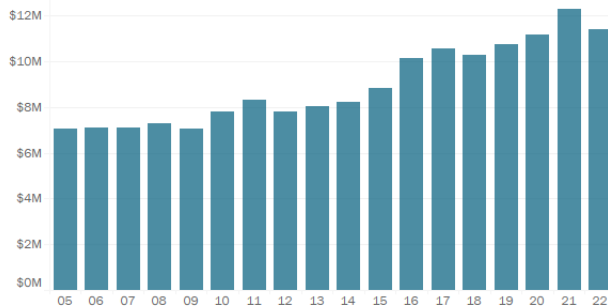

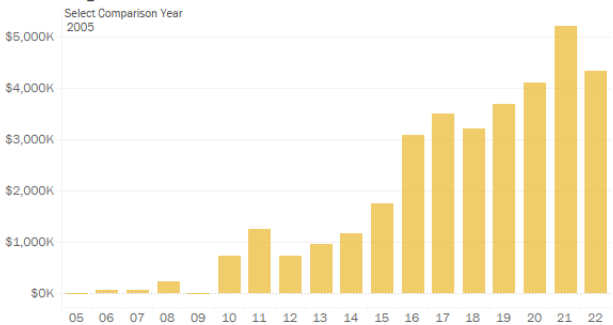

The City Street Construction Fund receives 20.0% of Road Use Tax Fund receipts after certain appropriations and statutory allocations are made. Total City Street Construction Fund revenue is distributed proportionally based upon the last census. Counties also receive funding from the Secondary Road Fund and the Farm-to-Market-Fund. This visual excludes payments to the Amana Colonies and cities that are no longer incorporated.
