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INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT AND JOBS ACT — NOVEMBER 2022

Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act. On November 15, 2021, the federal Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act was signed into law. The Act will provide funding to all states for infrastructure projects through a mix of new and established programs. Currently, reported grant amounts for the State of Iowa are still being determined, but some details are known. The table below displays distributions from the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act by department for FY 2022 through FY 2026. More information will be included as it becomes available.
