IOWA PUBLIC INFORMATION BOARD MEETING — JUNE 2023

Meeting. The Iowa Public Information Board met on July 20, 2023, at the Wallace State Office Building in Des Moines.

The Board took the following actions:

- **Dismissed Cases.** The Board dismissed eight complaint allegations. Two of the dismissed allegations were found to have had probable cause but were dismissed after recommended actions were met by the defendants. The Board found that the dismissed cases were either legally insufficient or did not fall under the Board's jurisdiction pursuant to Iowa Code chapters <u>21</u> and <u>22</u>.
- Accepted Cases. The Board accepted one complaint allegation against the Page County Board of Supervisors. Page County was accused and found in violation of not adhering to Iowa Code chapter 21 when the Board of Supervisors failed to provide an agenda or appropriate notice of their meeting discussing the levy of a jointly managed drainage ditch in Page County.
- **Reviewed Reports.** The Board was provided one final report regarding a complaint against the City of Zearing and was provided two reports on ongoing cases involving the Vinton City Council and the Tama County Auditor, respectively.

Next Meeting. The Board's next meeting will be held on August 17, 2023, at 1:00 p.m. in the Wallace State Office Building in Des Moines.
