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## **REVENUE ESTIMATING CONFERENCE — OCTOBER 2023**

**Revenue Estimate.** The Revenue Estimating Conference (REC) met on October 12, 2023, and increased the estimated FY 2024 net General Fund receipts by \$109.8 million compared to the FY 2024 adjusted March estimate.

**Fiscal Year 2024.** The October REC estimate for FY 2024 net General Fund receipts, including transfers, totals \$9.753 billion, a decrease of \$92.5 million (-0.9%) compared to actual FY 2023. The estimated changes include a decrease of 5.2% in gross personal income tax, an increase of 6.6% in gross sales/use tax, and a decrease of 8.3% in gross corporate income tax receipts. The following table provides additional detail for the FY 2024 revenue projection.

**Fiscal Year 2025.** The REC established an estimate of \$9.576 billion for FY 2025. This is a decrease of \$176.5 million (-1.8%) compared to the revised FY 2024 estimate. The estimated changes include a decrease of 2.3% in gross personal income tax, an increase of 5.5% in gross sales/use tax, and a decrease of 16.2% in gross corporate income tax receipts. The following table provides additional detail for the FY 2025 revenue projection.
