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## **REVENUE ESTIMATING CONFERENCE — DECEMBER 2023**

**Revenue Estimate.** The Revenue Estimating Conference (REC) met on December 13, 2023, and decreased the estimated FY 2024 net General Fund receipts by \$6.3 million compared to the FY 2024 October estimate.

**Fiscal Year 2024.** The December REC estimate for FY 2024 net General Fund receipts, including transfers, totals \$9.747 billion, a decrease of \$98.8 million (-1.0%) compared to actual FY 2023. The estimated changes include a decrease of 6.7% in gross personal income tax, an increase of 5.1% in gross sales/use tax, and an increase of 1.5% in gross corporate income tax receipts. The following table provides additional detail for the FY 2024 revenue projection.

**Fiscal Year 2025.** The REC established an estimate of \$9.637 billion for FY 2025. This is a decrease of \$109.4 million (-1.1%) compared to the FY 2024 estimate. The estimated changes include a decrease of 5.1% in gross personal income tax, an increase of 4.5% in gross sales/use tax, and a decrease of 14.5% in gross corporate income tax receipts. The following table provides additional detail for the FY 2025 revenue projection.
