IOWA UTILITIES COMMISSION MONTHLY MEETING — OCTOBER 2025

Meeting. The Iowa Utilities Commission (IUC) met on October 15, 2025, at the IUC Conference Room in Des Moines. The IUC approved the meeting minutes from the September 10, 2025, meeting. The following agenda items were discussed:

- An [update](#) on the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC). The FERC is an independent government agency that operates within the Department of Energy that regulates interstate energy transmission, licenses hydropower projects, approves interstate energy infrastructure projects, and ensures electricity grid reliability.

- An update on the monthly [financials](#).

Other business items presented to the IUC included:
