IOWA PUBLIC INFORMATION BOARD MEETING — JUNE 18, 2026

Meeting. The Iowa Public Information Board (Board) met on Thursday, June 18, 2026, at the Jessie Parker Building in Des Moines. The Board took the following actions:

- **Minutes.** The Board approved the minutes from the May 21, 2026, Board meeting.
- **Accepted Cases.** The Board accepted 19 consent agenda complaint allegations. The Board found that these complaint allegations fall under the Board's jurisdiction, are legally sufficient, and could have merit pursuant to Iowa Code section [23.8\(1\)](#).
- **Dismissed Cases.** The Board dismissed three consent agenda complaint allegations. The Board found that these complaint allegations did not fall under the Board's jurisdiction, were legally insufficient, were harmless error, or did not have merit pursuant to Iowa Code section [23.8\(2\)](#).
- **Investigative Reports.** The Board dismissed five investigative reports. The Board dismissed four investigative reports for lack of probable cause that violations occurred. The Board dismissed one investigative report as an exercise of administrative discretion.
- **Tabled Case.** The Board tabled one complaint allegation for further review.
- **Final Reports.** The Board approved the following four final reports:
 - A final report regarding a complaint alleging that the city of Storm Lake violated Iowa Code chapter [21](#) by conducting official business outside of a meeting setting. The Board dismissed the complaint allegation as successfully resolved.
 - A final report regarding a complaint alleging that the city of Sioux Center violated Iowa Code chapter 21 by charging unreasonable fees for a public records request and not completing the public records request. The Board dismissed the complaint allegation as successfully resolved.
 - A final report regarding a complaint alleging that the Sioux Center Public Library violated Iowa Code chapter [22](#) by charging unreasonable fees for a public records request. The Board dismissed the complaint allegation as successfully resolved.
 - A final report regarding a complaint alleging that the Sac County Board of Supervisors violated Iowa Code chapter 21 by improperly posting a meeting agenda. The Board dismissed the complaint allegation as successfully resolved.
- **Informal Resolution Report.** The Board approved an informal resolution report regarding a complaint alleging that the Oskaloosa Community School District (District) violated Iowa Code chapter 22 by not complying with a public records request from the complainant. As part of the informal resolution report, the District agreed to the following actions:
 - The District will provide information regarding whether three District members withheld records in their individual capacity as school board members in violation of Iowa Code chapter 22 to the Board.
 - The District will work with the Board to review withheld public records to determine which records to produce to the complainant.
 - The District will provide an affidavit outlining the process taken to retrieve public records on personal devices.
 - The District will review its current policies to address how and where to maintain public records, including language requiring the use of official government email or devices. A copy will be provided to the Board.
 - School board members will complete required Iowa Code chapter 22 training.
 - A signed copy of the informal resolution will be reviewed and approved and read into record at a school board meeting. The minutes of the meeting will be provided to the Board.

The terms of the informal resolution must be completed within 60 days of the informal resolution approval date.

Next Meeting. The next Board meeting will be held on July 16, 2026, at 1:00 p.m. at the Jessie Parker Building in Des Moines.
