



BOARD OF REGENTS TO CONSIDER INCREASING TUITION RATES

Telephonic Meeting. The Board of Regents plans to meet by telephone on May 8, 2017, to conduct a first reading of a proposal to increase tuition rates for the 2017-2018 academic year. Final action on the proposal is scheduled for the Board's June meeting.

Proposed Rates. The Board originally set the 2017-2018 tuition rates in December 2016. The rates set at that time represented increases over the 2016-2017 rates ranging between 2.0% and 3.0% for both resident undergraduate and graduate students.

The latest proposal increases those rates by another 3.0% for resident undergraduates. The rates for resident graduate students would be increased by another 2.5% to 3.0%. The table below compares the proposed 2017-2018 tuition rates to the 2016-2017 rates.
