COMMUNITY ATTRACTION AND TOURISM (CAT) COMMITTEE MEETING

Committee Meeting. The Community Attraction and Tourism (CAT) Committee met on July 12, 2017. The Committee took the following actions:

- Received a report on the status of the CAT Committee Program. There is currently \$5.6 million available, and 27 award applications have been received.
- Recommended the approval of the following two CAT awards:
 - King Theatre Renovation in Ida Grove (\$62,005).
 - Briggs Woods Conference Center in Hamilton County (\$350,000).

The CAT Committee is a subcommittee of the Enhance lowa Board and evaluates applications for CAT funding. Eligible projects must be available to the general public for public use and be primarily vertical infrastructure.
