



## **IOWA DROUGHT CONDITIONS AS OF AUGUST 15, 2017**

**Drought Continues.** Below is a map detailing drought conditions for lowa as of August 15, 2017. Currently, there are two areas in southern lowa categorized with extreme drought. There are also two areas with severe drought, three areas with moderate drought, and three areas that are abnormally dry. The information is from the <u>United States Drought Monitor</u>.





