PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY BOARD MEETING

Meeting. The Public Safety Advisory Board (PSAB) met September 20, 2017, in the Legislative Dining Room in the Iowa State Capitol.

Follow-Up to Research Requests. The Criminal and Juvenile Justice Planning (CJJP) Research Coordinator, Kile Beisner, presented on several topics in response to research requests from the last meeting. The topics included driver's license sanctions for drug offenses, banning guns for domestic abuse offenders, and the restoration of voting rights for felons. The Board discussed the current laws in Iowa for each topic, possible reforms, and the effects those reforms could have on the State.

2017 PSAB Report Recommendation Review. The PSAB annually submits a report of legislative recommendations to the General Assembly. In order to determine what should be included in the report, the Board discussed its policy priorities for the 2018 Legislative Session. The PSAB will submit the final report to the General Assembly on December 1, 2017.

Next Meeting. The Board is scheduled to meet Wednesday, November 15, 2017, in the Legislative Dining Room in the Iowa State Capitol.
