## **GOVERNOR'S BUDGET HEARING — DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE**

**Budget Hearing.** On November 20, 2017, Governor Kim Reynolds held a budget hearing for the Department of Justice. Attorney General Tom Miller presented the Department budget request for FY 2019 as summarized in an earlier *Fiscal Update Article*. Additionally, Attorney General Miller discussed his work with South Dakota on the issue of online sales tax collection. South Dakota has filed a petition for a writ of certiorari with the United States Supreme Court to overturn the current restrictions on the ability of an online retailer to collect sales tax.

**Department Request.** The Department submitted an FY 2019 request for General Fund appropriations totaling \$15.1 million. This is an increase of \$1.1 million compared to estimated FY 2018. This increase includes:

- \$250,000 for the Office of the Attorney General.
- \$595,000 for Legal Services Poverty Grants.
- \$300,000 for Farm Mediation Services.
