JUDICIAL BRANCH REQUEST — JUSTICE SYSTEM APPROPRIATIONS SUBCOMMITTEE

Fiscal Year 2019 Request. The Judicial Branch is requesting a total of \$192.6 million from the General Fund, an increase of \$13.8 million compared to estimated FY 2018, as presented in the table below. Under Iowa Code section <u>602.1301</u>, the Judicial Branch has until December 1, 2017, to submit its budget request to the General Assembly.

Judicial Branch. The Judicial Branch is requesting increases from the General Fund totaling approximately \$13.8 million, including:

- \$6.8 million for full staffing of the Judicial Branch and continued operation of specialty courts.
- \$6.5 million for technological projects and maintenance. Projects include information security and infrastructure, statewide conversion of historic paper inventory to digital storage, an online access-to-justice portal, and enhanced jury management software.
- \$85,400 for a specialty courts study. The purpose of the study would be to evaluate the structure and practices of the 47 existing specialty courts.
- \$500,000 for digital audio recording equipment for 25 district associate courtrooms across the State. The recorders would be utilized when no court reporters are available to make the record. There is a court reporter shortage, with 12 positions currently vacant.

Vacant Positions. There are 115 vacant positions in the Judicial Branch, including 11 judicial officers and 20 juvenile court officers. The Judicial Branch has eliminated 67 positions (4.0% of authorized full-time equivalent positions) from clerk of district court offices. The FY 2019 budget request does not include funding for those 67 eliminated positions.
