EXECUTIVE COUNCIL MEETING — DECEMBER 18, 2017

Meeting. The Executive Council met on Monday, December 18, 2017. The following are highlighted agenda items approved by the Council:

- The Department of Justice, Attorney General's Office, requested the Council approve payment for expenses pursuant to lowa Code section <u>7D.10</u>. The Council approved a total payment of approximately \$17,400 that is intended to cover court costs and expenses related to prosecuting commitments under lowa Code chapter <u>229A</u> for the Sexually Violent Predator (SVP) program.
- A total of approximately \$3,200 was unanimously approved for payment of various requested emergency allocations. The payment is intended to cover repair costs of a State Patrol car after an accident involving a raccoon in Keokuk County.
- The Council also unanimously approved payment of various cost items totaling approximately \$4,200.
 This includes a payment of approximately \$3,400 intended to cover repair costs resulting from storm damage to a State Patrol car operating out of Dubuque.

State Board of Canvass. Upon adjournment of the Executive Council meeting, the State Board of Canvass met to discuss the recent Special Election for State Senate District 3 held on December 12, 2017. The Senate seat in District 3 was left vacant after the resignation of former Senator Bill Anderson, R-Pierson, and filled by former Representative Jim Carlin, R-Sioux City. The State Board of Canvass verified the Special Election results and voted unanimously to adopt the canvass of the votes as tabulated.

Next Meeting. The next meeting has not been scheduled at this time.
