GOVERNOR'S BUDGET HEARING — OFFICE OF THE CHIEF INFORMATION OFFICER

On November 13, 2018, Governor Kim Reynolds held a budget hearing for the Office of the Chief Information Officer (OCIO). Chief Information Officer Robert von Wolfradt presented the Office's FY 2020 budget request. Officer von Wolfradt requested a status quo budget of \$12.7 million from the Technology Reinvestment Fund (TRF).

In the past year, the OCIO won the Center for Digital Government's Digital Experience Award. The OCIO currently provides cybersecurity for all State agencies, elected offices, and branches of government. The OCIO also provides cybersecurity training to all 99 counties as well as 8 cities, 17 schools, a county hospital, and one utility. The OCIO investigated 2,019 cybersecurity incidents in 2017, and year to date in 2018, has investigated 2,043 cybersecurity incidents.

For FY 2020, the OCIO is looking to continue to update the State's cybersecurity strategy, review State agency participation and increase cybersecurity standardization, lower the cost of Internet transport for all Iowa providers, and assist in providing faster Internet for all Iowans.
