- 1 Section 1. Section 11.5A, Code 2024, is amended to read as 2 follows:
- 3 11.5A Audit or examination costs.
- 4 When requested by the auditor of state, the department
- 5 of management shall transfer from any unappropriated funds
- 6 in the state treasury an amount not exceeding the expenses
- 7 and prorated salary costs already paid to perform audits or
- 8 examinations of state departments and agencies, the offices
- 9 of the judicial branch, and federal financial assistance as
- 10 defined in the federal Single Audit Act, 31 U.S.C. §7501, et
- 11 seq., received by all other departments, as listed in section
- 12 $\frac{11.5B_r}{}$ for which payments by agencies have not been made. Upon
- 13 payment by the departments, the auditor of state shall credit
- 14 the payments to the state treasury.

- 19 The auditor of state shall be reimbursed by a state

- 11 any subsequent assistance provided by the auditor of state.
- 12 Sec. 4. NEW SECTION. 11.5D Billing rates.
- 13 The auditor of state shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
- 14 17A to establish the hourly billing rate at which audit
- 15 services are performed by state auditors as described in
- 16 section 11.31.
- 17 EXPLANATION
- 18 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 19 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 20 This bill relates to the reimbursement of certain audit
- 21 expenses to the auditor of state.
- 22 The bill strikes a list of specified departments and
- 23 agencies that must reimburse the auditor of state for
- 24 performing audits and examinations, and instead provides that
- 25 any audited department or agency must reimburse the auditor
- 26 of state for performing audits and examinations. The bill
- 27 requires the auditor of state to adopt billing rates by rule.
