A BILL FOR

- $\ensuremath{\mathbf{1}}$ An Act relating to core academic indicators and assessments of
- 2 science for students enrolled in certain grades.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. Section 256.7, subsection 21, paragraph b,
- 2 unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2017, is amended to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 A set of core academic indicators in mathematics and reading
- 5 in grades four, eight, and eleven, a set of core academic
- 6 indicators in science in grades five, eight, and eleven ten,
- 7 and another set of core indicators that includes but is not
- 8 limited to graduation rate, postsecondary education, and
- 9 successful employment in Iowa.
- 10 Sec. 2. Section 256.7, subsection 21, paragraph b,
- 11 subparagraph (2), Code 2017, is amended to read as follows:
- 12 (2) Notwithstanding subparagraph (1), for the school year
- 13 beginning July 1, 2017, and each succeeding school year,
- 14 the rules shall provide require that all students enrolled
- 15 in school districts in grades three through eleven shall be
- 16 administered an assessment during the last quarter of the
- 17 school year that in mathematics and reading and all students
- 18 enrolled in school districts in grades five, eight, and ten
- 19 be administered an assessment during the last quarter of the
- 20 school year in science. The assessments administered under
- 21 this subparagraph shall, at a minimum assesses, assess the
- 22 core academic indicators identified in this paragraph "b";
- 23 is be aligned with the Iowa common core academic content
- 24 standards pursuant to subsection 28 in both content and rigor;
- 25 accurately describes describe student achievement and growth
- 26 for purposes of the school, the school district, and state
- 27 accountability systems; and provides provide valid, reliable,
- 28 and fair measures of student progress toward college or career
- 29 readiness.
- 30 EXPLANATION
- 31 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 32 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 33 This bill directs the state board of education to adopt rules
- 34 to provide for a set of core academic indicators in science in
- 35 grades 5, 8, and 10, and to require that all students enrolled

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- ${\tt l}$ in school districts in grades 5, 8, and 10 be administered a
- 2 science assessment.
- 3 Currently in Code, the state board's rules are to provide
- 4 for a set of core science academic indicators for grades 8 and
- 5 11 and for all students in school district grades 3 through
- 6 11 to be administered an assessment that assesses the core
- 7 academic indicators (including mathematics, reading, and
- 8 science). The bill does not change the assessment requirements
- 9 for mathematics and reading.
