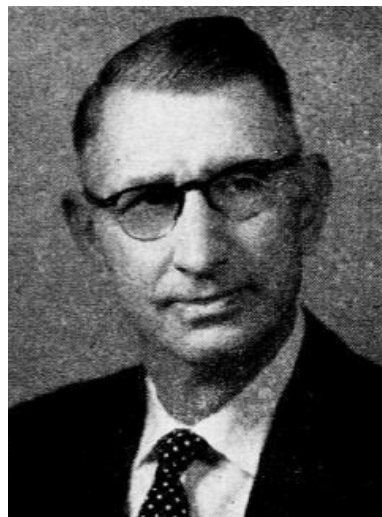




HOXIE, Frank M., Shenandoah
