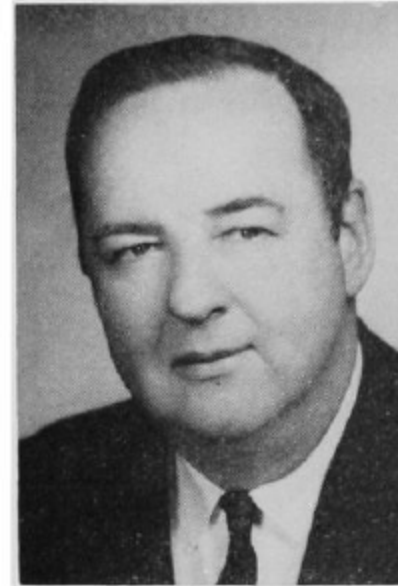


BUREN, John Leonard, Forest City
