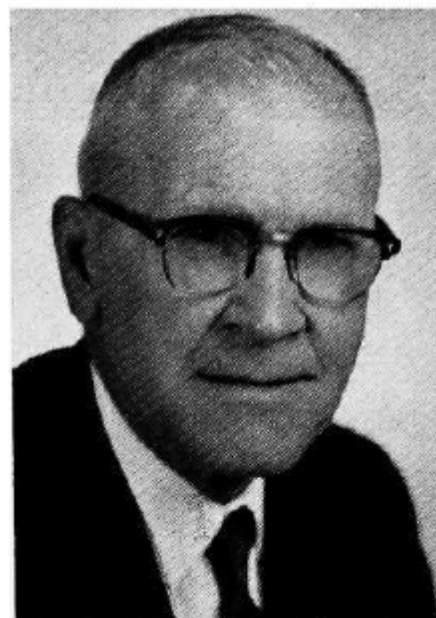


JARVIS, Fred M., Alta
