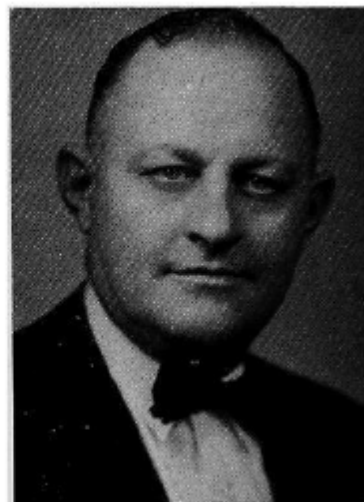


**WEIK, Charles (Chuck). Spirit Lake
