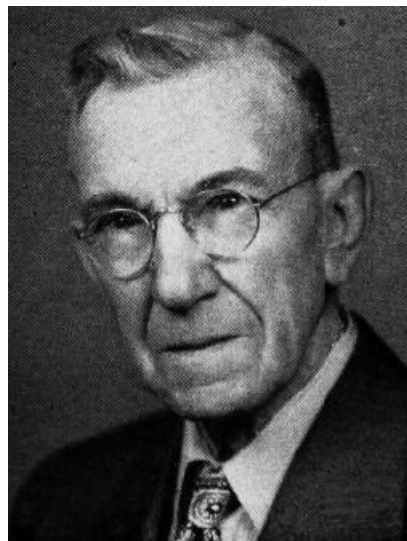


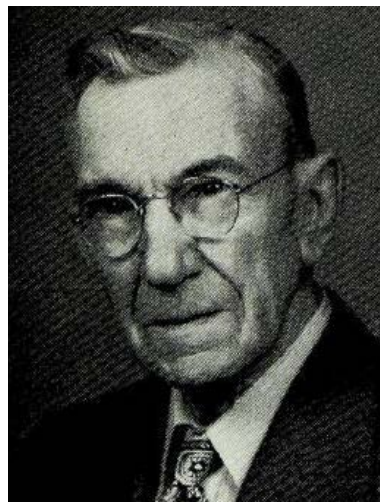
**BLOEDEL, Alexander Stanley, Tabor
