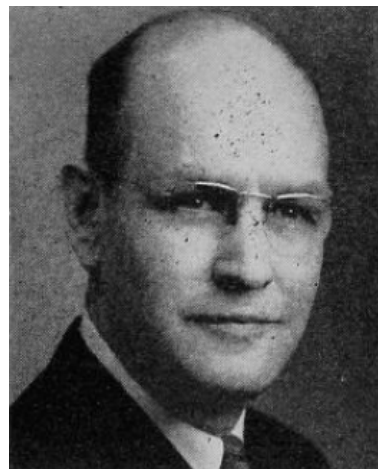




CLEM, A. D., Sioux City Republican
