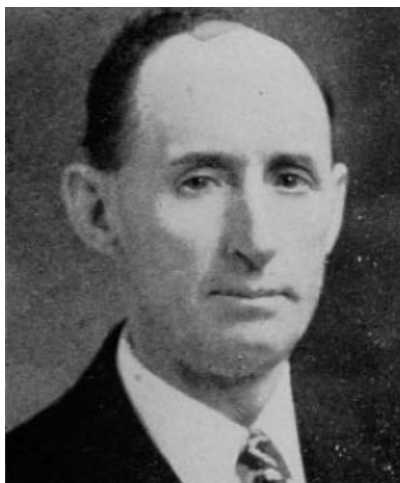
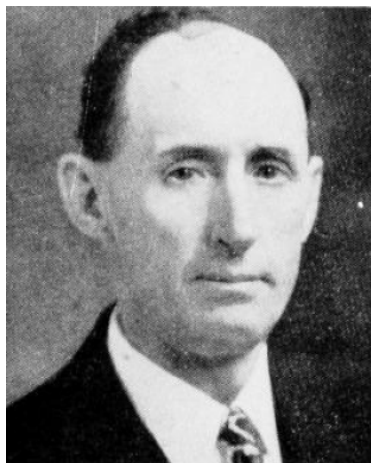




FULK, Edward W., Clarinda
