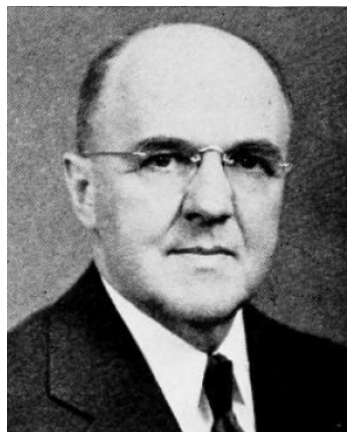
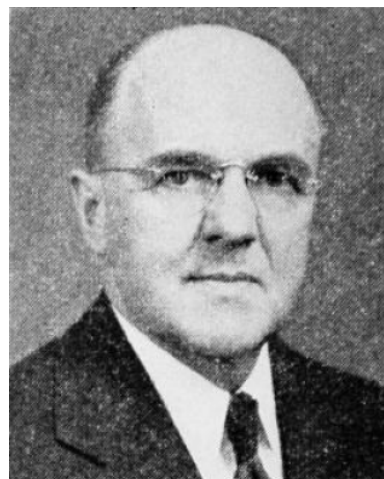




**FARMER, George E., Cedar Rapids Linn County
