Was re-elected in 1902 and 1904, and in 1906 he accepted the position of assistant cashier of the First National Bank of Red Oak, Iowa. In 1907 he entered the real estate and insurance business. Was married in 1893 to Emma E. Wallin, of Page county, Iowa, and has two daughters, Myrtle and Dorothy. Elected representative in 1916. Re-elected in 1918. Republican in politics.
