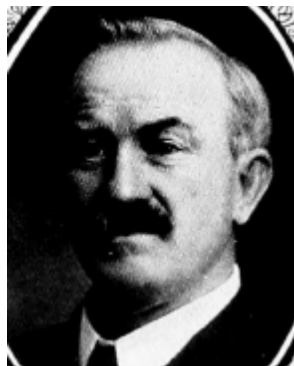




REUBEN A. LENOCKER,
