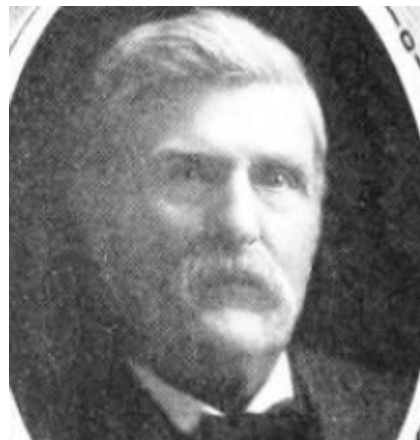


**MAHLON HARVEY,**
