Married Miss Anna Burkle October 18, 1877, in Dyersville, since that time has lived on a farm. Has thirteen children, seven boys and six girls, all living. Was township clerk for twelve years. Elected Representative in 1908. A Catholic in religion. A Democrat in politics.
