He moved to Iowa at an early age and was educated in the common schools of Iowa. Has been a farmer and stock raiser practically all his life and now lives on a fine farm within a mile of the old homestead where his parents settled thirty-six years ago. Has held various township offices and was a member of the Board of Supervisors of his county when elected to the Senate. Elected Senator in 1903 and served during the Thirtieth, Thirty-first and Thirty-second General Assemblies. A Democrat in politics.
