Introduction

Class size reduction for the early elementary grades remained a state goal in 2008-2009, continuing efforts initiated by the Iowa Early Intervention Block Grant Program (House File 743) in 1999. Funding was allocated in 2008-2009 towards reduction of class sizes for kindergarten through third grade. Funding remained at \$29.3 million in FY 2009 unchanged since FY 2005 (see Table 1). Iowa’s class size reduction goal established in Iowa Code Chapter 256D is 17 students per classroom for basic skills instruction. Beginning in FY2010, funding of Iowa Early Intervention Block Grant Program will be rolled into the State Aid formula. This will allow the funding of this program to grow along with the overall funding of school districts across Iowa.

Methodology

Public school districts report the number of kindergarten, first, second and third grade classroom sections, students, teachers, and aides by building during the Fall Basic Educational Data Survey (BEDS). Special education teachers and aides are not included in the reporting. Physical education, art, music and other “specialty” and “pull-out” program (such as Title I reading and math) teachers are also excluded from the teacher count.

Some districts utilize multi-age classrooms for their K-3 students. For example, a classroom may combine first and second grade students in one room. Districts report these combination classrooms as grade level “Other” on the Class Size submission but these classrooms are not included in this report.

The Department of Education calculated average class size for kindergarten through third grade at the district and state level. Average class size equals the number of students divided by the number of classrooms for each grade level.

$$\text{Average Class Size} = \text{Number of Students} / \text{Number of Classrooms}$$

Since average class size uses the number of classrooms as the denominator, adding additional teachers to a classroom does not lower the average class size for that grade level. The use of classroom aides also does not reduce average class size at the district or state level.

Findings

This report provides class size data from 1998-1999 to 2008-2009 for kindergarten through third grade. Average class size increased in 2008-2009 for kindergarten, first and third grade compared to 2007-2008 (see Table 2 and Figure 1). The kindergarten and third grade averages were at the second highest level since 1998-1999. The second grade average remained steady when compared to 2007-2008. Despite the increases, average class size remained below 20 students for kindergarten and first grade in 2008-2009. Third grade continued to show the highest average class size per classroom of the grades examined, at 21 students per classroom for 2008-2009, and remained above 20 students in each year studied.

Overall the increase in average class size in 2008-2009 continued the trend in recent years. Average class size declined for kindergarten through second grade from 1998-1999 through 2001-2002 but increased in each of the subsequent years through 2005-2006. In 2006-2007, kindergarten average class size declined slightly. In 2007-2008, kindergarten was the only grade to increase average class size from 2006-2007. In 2008-2009, all grades with the exception of second grade increased slightly from 2007-2008. Third grade showed a decline from 1998-1999 through 2002-2003 but experienced alternating increases and decreases in the following years. Third grade remained steady in 2007-2008 when compared to 2006-2007, and increased slightly in 2008-2009. First and second grade show steady increases from 2002-2003 through 2006-2007. Both grades decreased slightly in 2007-2008.

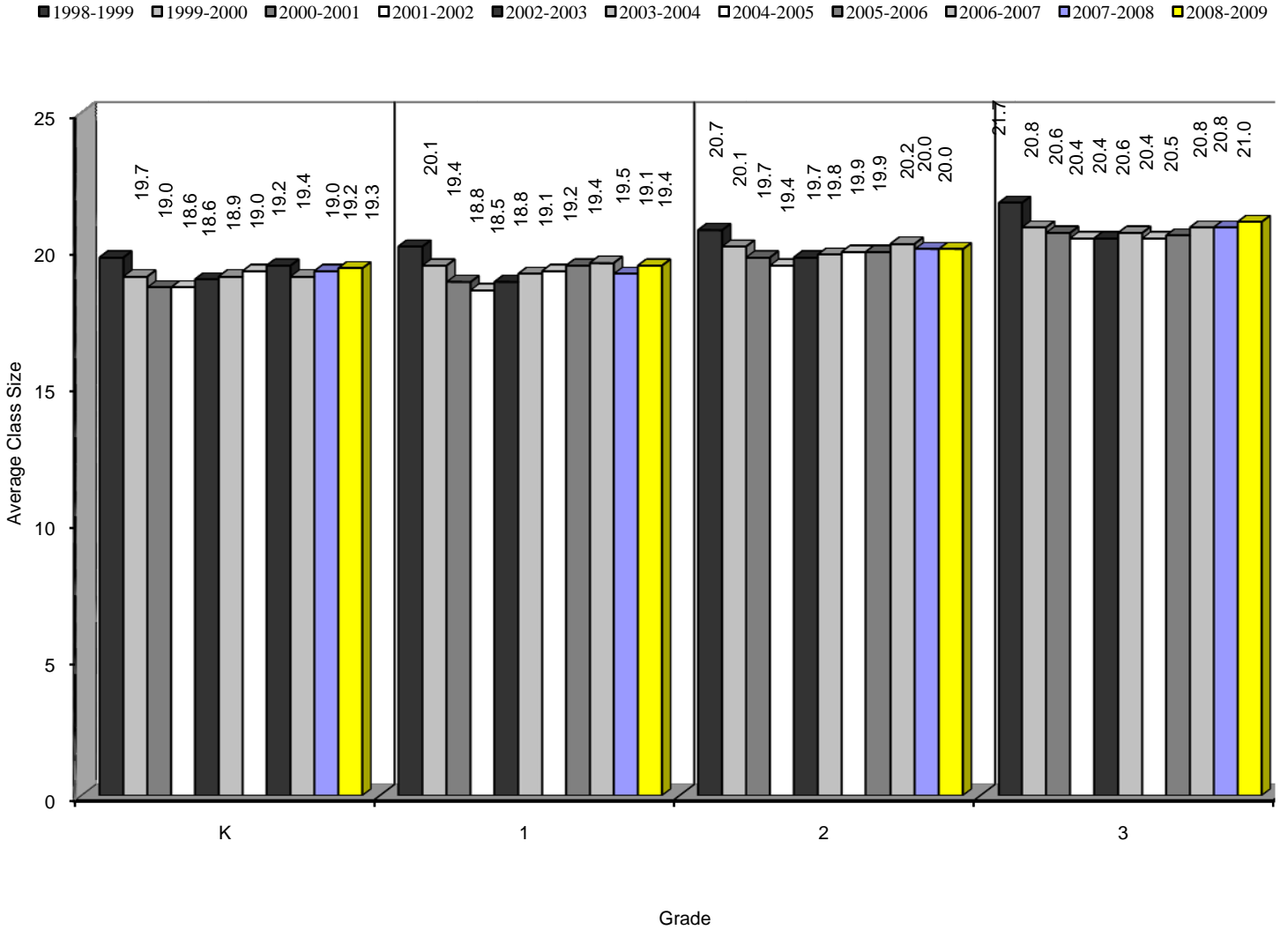

Smaller districts were more likely to meet the state goal of 17.0 students per classroom than larger districts in 2008-2009. The average class size for kindergarten and first grades was below 17.0 students per classroom for the <300 and 300-599 enrollment categories in 2008-2009. The <300 category was below 17 students for second and third grade.

The larger districts were more likely to show the highest average class sizes in 2008-2009. The 2,500-7,499 and 7,500+ enrollment categories experienced average class sizes of 21 or more for second and third grade in 2008-2009. The average class size for these enrollment categories remained above 20 students per classroom for the past seven years.

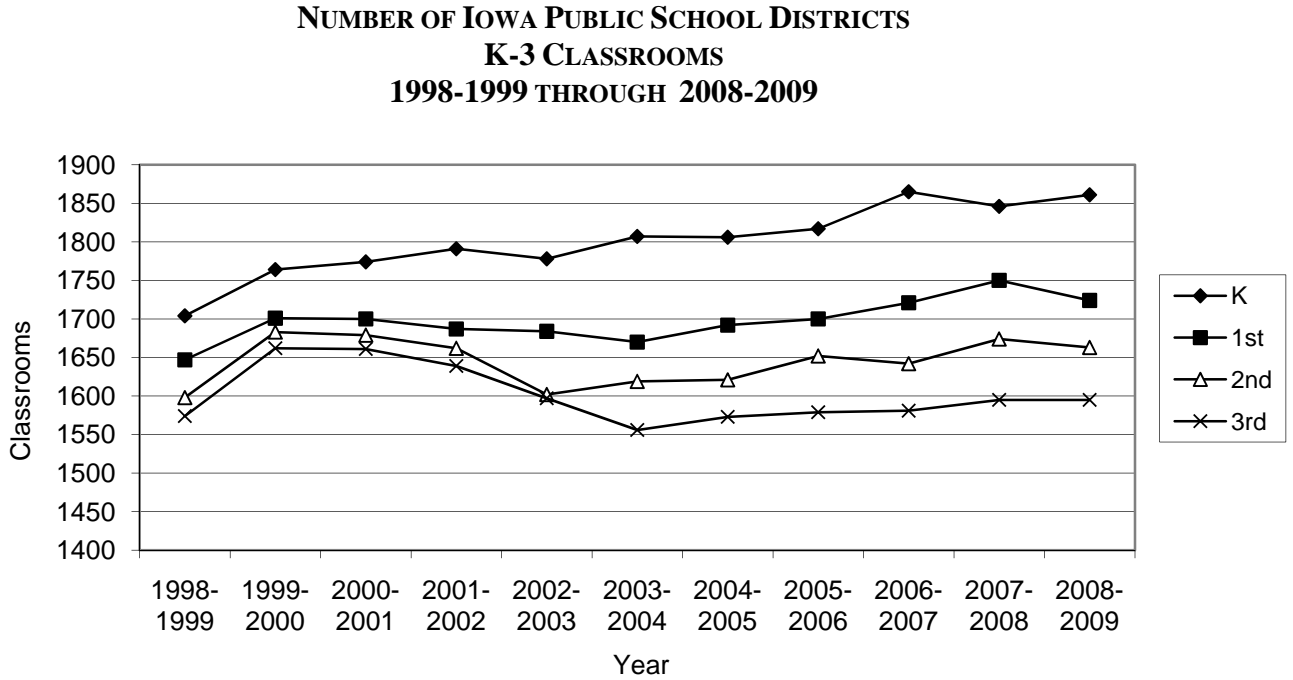

The percentage of classrooms above the state goal of 17 students per classroom increased in 2008-2009 from the previous year. For example, the percentage of kindergarten classrooms above 17 students went from 71.3 percent in 2007-2008 to 73.6 percent in 2008-2009.

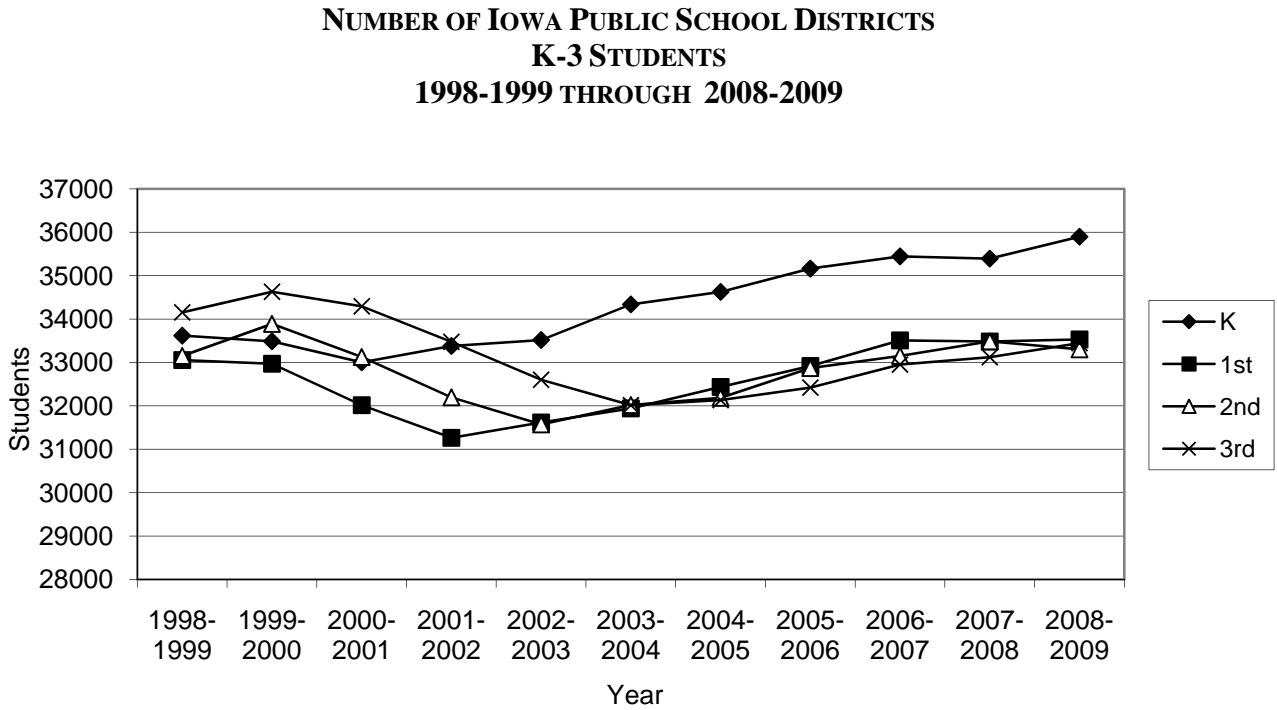
Third grade showed a higher percentage of large classrooms compared to K-2 in 2008-2009, with 85.5 percent of third grade classrooms above 17 students per class. Although the third grade percentage was the highest, it was down compared to the 1998-1999 level of 87.4 percent. This trend appears to be consistent across most grade levels with the ratio of students per class room lower than the 1998-1999 levels.

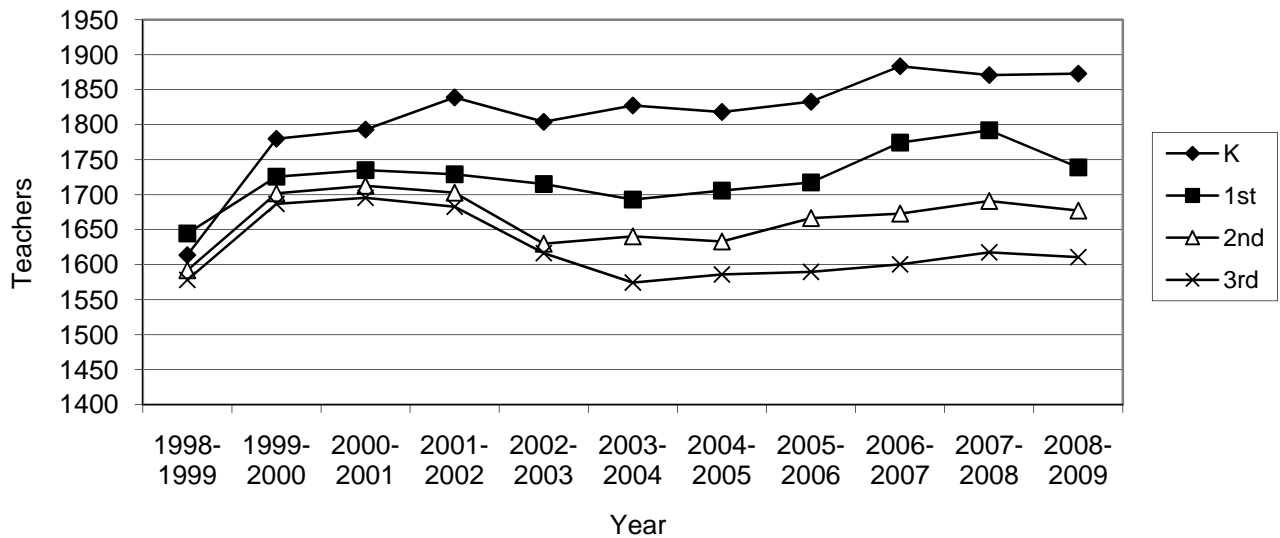

The growth in the number of classrooms and teachers has outpaced the growth in the number of students for each grade level from 1998-1999 to 2008-2009 (see Figures 2-4). For example, the number of first grade students increased 1.4 percent since 1998-1999 but the number of first grade classrooms increased 4.7 percent during the same period. The number of teachers increased 5.7 percent.

Declines in average class size from 1998-1999 to 2008-2009 outpaced the declines in enrollment during the same period for first and second grade (see Tables 9 and 10). During this period, average class size declined 2.0 percent for kindergarten while enrollment increased 7.7 percent.

Expenditures

District expenditures increased slightly in FY 2008 to \$31,411,126.23 with salaries consuming the largest percentage of the total. Purchased Services, Supplies and the Other categories were below 1.0 percent each (see Table 11 and Figure 5).

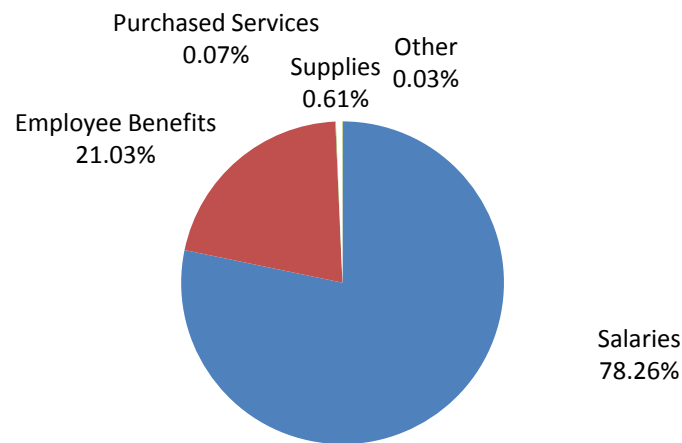

In FY 2008 the largest districts (+7,500) spent the smallest percentage of early intervention funds on staff salaries at 75.6 percent. Small districts in the <300-599 and 600-999 enrollment categories spent the highest percentage of funds on staff salaries, at above 80 percent, yet paid fewer benefits than the larger districts. The very smallest districts utilized supplies the most in FY 2008 at nearly 3 percent. Overall, the percentage difference of categorical expenditures fluctuated very little based on the size of a district.
