Introduction:

Iowa Code 29C.20A(5) requires the Iowa Department of Human Services to report annually, by January 1 of each year, to the Legislative Fiscal Committee and the Government Oversight Committee concerning the activities of the Iowa Individual Assistance Grant Program (IIAGP) for the previous fiscal year.

Overview:

State Fiscal Year 2021

Beginning in August 2020, lowa began to experience severe storm systems which created high winds, heavy rains, flash flooding, and tornadoes resulting in significant damage to private/personal property across some lowa counties.

This report covers expenditures for declared disasters from July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021.

Some expenses from June 2020 proclaimed disasters were expended in State Fiscal Year 2021.

The majority of expenses from the June 2021 proclaimed disasters will be included in the State Fiscal Year 2022 annual report since the funds were expended in State Fiscal Year 2022.
