Subject: Iowa Board of Medicine Veteran's Report, Iowa Code Sections 272C.4 (11) and

272C.4 (12)

Pursuant to Iowa Code Section 272C.4(13), the Iowa Board of Medicine provides the following report to Governor Kim Reynolds and the General Assembly of Iowa concerning the Board's licensure of individuals who have served honorably on federal active duty, state active duty or national guard active duty as outlined in the provisions of Iowa Code sections 272C.4(11) and Iowa Code 272C.4(12). The information provided is for the period of January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021 and includes applicants for a license to practice medicine and acupuncture.

272C.4(11) - Credits received by individuals for education, training and service: <u>0</u> (No applicants for medical or acupuncture licenses requested this credit.)

272C.4(12) - Expedited licensing of an individual who is licensed in a similar profession or occupation in another state and who indicated veteran: <u>64</u> medical license applicants. (No veteran sought an acupuncture license in the period covered by this report.)
