lowa Code 262.92 charges the Regent universities with encouraging resident minority students to attend their institutions, addressing income barriers to access, and providing information about higher education opportunities early in the lives of young lowans. The University of Northern lowa Office of Admissions has implemented a multicultural recruitment plan in support of the College Bound Program, with a focus on offering traditional and non-traditional activities designed to provide access and support for students who have been traditionally underrepresented in higher education. The University of Northern lowa 2017-2022 Strategic Plan, Supporting Goal 1: Diversity and Inclusion outlines institution-wide priorities for the recruitment, retention, and success of diverse populations. Our goals for the College Bound and IMAGES Programs align with university-wide strategic initiatives and supporting metrics; see https://president.uni.edu/strategicplan.

The assistant director for diversity recruitment in collaboration with the associate director for recruitment and outreach and director of admissions in the Office of Admissions, oversee the College Bound Program. Responsibilities include coordinating efforts with UNI's strategic plan and multicultural recruitment plan, engaging with campus partners to coordinate campus programs, and visiting high schools and community-based organizations across the state to increase the number of College Bound participants served by UNI. The Office of Admissions has worked to facilitate meaningful relationships with high schools and community organizations in the Cedar Valley and targeted high schools with high minority populations across the state, including Waterloo, Des Moines, Sioux City, and Cedar Rapids public schools.

UNI student leaders support the multicultural recruitment plan by helping with campus and community programs designed for racial/ethnic minority students. Ethnic Student Promoters (ESP) is a group of approximately 20 current UNI students from culturally diverse backgrounds who assist with recruitment events on- and off-campus, leading campus tours, hosting visitors for lunch, sharing their experiences as student panelists, and visiting high schools to promote college access. ESP students are excellent representatives of the university and serve as connections to their home communities, high schools and/or community colleges.

Campus Visits

Campus visit programs are conducted throughout the year for College Bound students. Various types of visit programs, detailed below, provide information on admission requirements, the application process, applying for scholarships, financial aid, support services, orientation programs, a campus tour, lunch, and question and answer time with a student panel that includes members of ESP. Fall and early spring visits included:

Individual Campus Visits

Individual campus visits include an appointment with an admissions counselor, campus tour and lunch in the dining center. Individual appointments are personalized based on a student's interests and cover admission requirements, financial aid information, major requirements, answers to student and family questions, and when requested, a meeting with the student's academic program. Individual visits and associated printed materials are also offered in Spanish, allowing students and families from Spanish-speaking families full access to the college exploration experience.

Group Visits

UNI Office of Admissions staff and campus partners provide opportunities throughout the year for TRIO, AVID, AI Exito, IJAG, and more high school groups and community based organizations to bring groups to experience campus. Students receive a presentation on the admission process, financial aid and scholarships, housing, and student life, as well as a campus tour and lunch. Visit agendas are adapted to accommodate each group's travel schedule and student interests. Most of the groups visiting campus are college preparation programs. The Office of Admissions assists with busing for group visits at the request of the community based organization or high school. *Note: COVID suspended in-person group visits. However, virtual visits and outreach to students in the organizations above continued throughout 2020-21.*

Multicultural Visit Days

Staff and faculty from UNI's Office of Admissions, all four undergraduate colleges, Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships, and Department of Residence collaborate to offer a campus visit day that introduces students in grades 9 - 12 to UNI's academic programs, living opportunities, admission process, and financial aid opportunities. Ethnic student organizations host a browsing fair session for visitors to learn about how to connect and get involved with others who have similar interests and backgrounds. ESP members provide escorts to visit activities, campus tours, student panels, and much needed connections for prospective racial/ethnic minority students. The Office of Admissions provides busing to students and families who might not otherwise be able to attend a college visit day. Note: *Due to COVID, these opportunities were hosted virtually*.

Multicultural Admitted Student Days

UNI holds events designed to assist admitted seniors and community college transfer students with the end of the admission process through the transition to enrollment. These admitted student days are offered in the fall and spring, and each includes an opportunity for admitted multicultural students and their families to connect one-to-one with UNI faculty and staff from diverse cultural backgrounds. The focus is on next steps in the transition process, including opportunities to learn more about individual majors through interactive activities within academic departments. Students and parents also meet with financial aid counselors to review financial aid awards, finalize housing contracts and related questions, and sign up for summer orientation.

College Fairs

Each year UNI Office of Admissions staff participate in college fairs across Iowa. Students have the opportunity to visit with an admissions or academic college representative and fill out a contact card which ensures they receive follow up information about the university and the admission process. College fairs are sponsored by organizations including the Iowa Association for College Admission Counseling, educational institutions, and community-based groups throughout the state. In order to enhance outreach to College Bound students, the multicultural recruitment team and campus colleagues attended college fairs designed to recruit racial/ethnic minority students from across Iowa such as the Quad Cities Minority Partnership College Fair and the LatinX fair in Des Moines. *Due to COVID, most events were held virtually in 2020-21*.

Community Outreach

I'll Make Me a World in Iowa

UNI is a supporting sponsor for this annual event in Des Moines, designed to highlight African American art, culture, and contributions. UNI staff and students participate in the two-day festival each year, which includes a college fair, Black History Month trivia competition, sessions on academic and career areas, and college tabling. UNI Office of Admissions staff and ESP student leaders have also given presentations on how to make college affordable, including scholarships and the Free Application for Federal Student Aid.

TRIO

UNI actively collaborates with TRIO programs throughout the state in an effort to reach and serve students from groups traditionally underrepresented in higher education. The UNI Office of Admissions collaborates regularly with UNI-sponsored TRIO programs at the UNI Center for Urban Education (UNI-CUE) by speaking to ETS students about college preparations, admission requirements, and financial aid.

The UNI multicultural recruitment team maintains close contact with UNI-CUE program directors who lead Classic Upward Bound, Educational Talent Search, Educational Opportunity Center, and various tutoring and academic support services for the community. We engage in partnership through regular meetings between programs directors and admissions which allows for more collaborative and purposeful outreach and access efforts.

Iowa College Access Network (ICAN) Financial Aid Nights

UNI hosted several virtual ICAN financial aid nights throughout the fall and spring. These programs provide students and their parents with an overview of the financial aid process.

Hispanic/Latino Community Outreach

In an effort to expand UNI's resources for Spanish speaking families, we have translated admissions publications and the financial aid website to Spanish. Additionally, we currently employ thee admissions staff and one financial aid staff who speak Spanish.

Each year, the Office of Admissions, Ethnic Student Promoters, and UNIdos (Hispanic/Latino Student Union) host a booth at the Iowa's Latino Heritage Festival. During this day-long program, staff and students hand out informational brochures and culturally-specific giveaways and showcase what it means to be a student at UNI. (Held virtually in 2020-21)

Black/African American Community Outreach

As referenced earlier, UNI is a supporting sponsor each year for the I'll Make Me A World event, the largest African American festival in Iowa. UNI Office of Admissions staff and campus partners also collaborate with KBBG in Waterloo, the first African American owned satellite FM radio station in Iowa, through participation in the annual KBBG Parade. Each of these community outreach events engage students of all ages as well as family members and community stakeholders, and include the distribution of UNI information and promotional materials. (Held virtually in 2020-21)

High School Visits

Each year UNI admissions representatives visit high schools to speak with prospective students about the admissions process, financial aid, scholarships, housing, and student life. Students provide contact information in order to receive follow-up communication about UNI and the admission process, and admissions representatives encourage students to schedule a campus visit. The admission office continues this engagement in the local community by maintaining a strong and consistent presence at Waterloo East and West High Schools. This engagement in Waterloo high schools includes offering office hours each month to speak with students about UNI, as well as meeting regularly with students. *Due to COVID, most high school visits were held virtually.*

Promotion of College Bound activities to students and parents

Events are promoted to students using a variety of approaches and media in order to reach multiple audiences across the state. Contact information is collected from students during various programs and activities in the community as well as on-campus, and through referrals and web inquiry forms. This student information is entered into the Constituent Relationship Management (CRM) Salesforce system, and then prospective students and their families

receive ongoing information about future College Bound and recruitment events. Students receive information upcoming visits from UNI recruitment counselors to their high schools, college fairs in their area, and open house and related campus visit opportunities. The UNI Office of Admissions works closely with community programs such as TRIO to bring groups of students to campus, often providing transportation in order to increase access, and provides programs in interested communities. We are also working to develop a stronger presence in minority communities by co-sponsoring programs with partners across the state.

Community leaders and high school personnel, working with current and prospective multicultural students, assist in encouraging parental involvement in outreach programs. Parental involvement opportunities include chaperoning groups that visit campus, participating in campus activities provided for their students, accompanying students to community events and college fairs, attending parent nights hosted by UNI Office of Admissions staff in select high schools, and engaging in activities and meetings with their students. Specific sessions are designed and provided for parents regarding financial aid and scholarships, options for students not meeting standard admission requirements, housing, and supporting students' academic success. As noted earlier, admission and financial aid materials are provided in Spanish in print and on the web in order to maximize parent engagement in the admission process.

Successful Activities

1. Campus Visit

For College Bound students, the campus visit is a critical element in the decision making process. During a campus visit, prospective students learn about admission and financial aid processes, and tour the campus to see residence halls, classrooms, and dining facilities. Ethnic Student Promoters members assist in these visits by guiding prospective students, family members, and counselors on campus tours, accompanying them to lunch in a dining center, and sharing their experiences as successful university students. The focus of each visit is to provide students with adequate information about UNI while also helping them understand the overall importance of pursuing higher education. Multicultural Visit Days and group visits by TRIO Programs also provide customized, effective campus visit experiences for students. While many of these visit events were held virtually in 2020-21, we were still able to reach out to many multicultural students to provide information about college going and UNI specifically.

2. Community College Transfers

Community colleges with substantial multicultural enrollments are identified for specific visits from the multicultural recruitment team. Staff members make contact with community college advisors in collaboration with the transfer team in the Office of Admissions, and inform them of upcoming events. Students identified and referred during this process are entered in the

Constituent Relationship Management (CRM) Salesforce system and receive transfer-specific follow-up information about the admission, transition, and enrollment process.

3. Expanded Hispanic/Latino Community Outreach

Expanding our Spanish language print, online, and in-person (through bi-lingual admissions staff members) resources has been an important achievement in serving College Bound students and their families. UNI is commitment to building upon these resources by continuing to expand the availability of admission, financial aid, and student success information in multiple languages.

4. Community Outreach

We continue to strengthen our relationship with TRIO groups by offering more programming on campus and in Des Moines and Cedar Rapids. UNI continues to build upon these relationship by offering additional programming throughout lowa, and supporting TRIO staff in their activities to promote college to these students.

INTRODUCTION

The University of Iowa is committed to a climate that respects and values diversity and inclusion, to the recruitment and retention of students, faculty and staff who contribute to diversity, and to administrative procedures and programs that support these initiatives. *The Strategic Plan for the University of Iowa, 2016-2021* recognizes diversity as a core value of the UI that sets us on the path towards promoting excellence in education by increasing the diversity of the faculty, staff and students and providing a welcoming and inclusive climate for all members of our community.

The College Bound and IMAGES programs foster the university's diversity goals by supporting outreach to lowa minority students. The purpose of this outreach is to encourage them to pursue opportunities in higher education and to provide financial support to help them realize their goals. The College Bound and IMAGES programs are important to the university's wider efforts to promote and maintain a culturally diverse learning environment. Additional university programs of community outreach, financial aid and scholarships, cultural centers, academic support programs, cultural studies courses and curricula, multicultural campus organizations and performance groups, cultural events and celebrations, and other resources are used to support these outreach efforts and create a welcoming and supportive campus environment for all students, faculty and staff.

At the University of Iowa, the Executive Vice President and Provost, the Associate Vice President for Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion, and the directors within the Division of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion coordinate and oversee many of the university's diversity efforts. With assistance from the Office of Admissions, the Center for Diversity and Enrichment administers the College Bound Program, and with the Office of Student Financial Aid, the IMAGES program.

This report summarizes College Bound activities and IMAGES scholarships awarded during the 2020-2021 academic cycle. Information for the report has been compiled from data available July 1, 2021.

COLLEGE BOUND

Purpose and Funding Allocation (Table B) - College Bound and IMAGES were established by the lowa Legislature. These programs are intended to provide lowa minority students with information and experiences relating to opportunities offered at the Regents universities. Consistent with these purposes, the University of Iowa has developed a range of programs for elementary, middle, and secondary students and their families that include academic enrichment, encouragement to consider attending a post-secondary institution, and admissions information. Funds are allocated annually from the University of Iowa General Education Fund to support the College Bound program. In 2020-2021, \$106,773 was expended to support these efforts.

In the past year, the most successful programs have been college-bound campus visits. Additional details and specific outreach and recruitment activities in 2020-2021 conducted under the College Bound Program are listed and described in the **Appendix**.

College Bound Participation (**Table F2**) - For academic year 2020-2021, a total of 830 lowa resident students in kindergarten through twelfth grade participated in College Bound programs hosted by the University of Iowa. Participation of students in a College Bound program activity is recorded by the university and vouchers are issued to secondary school student participants (grades 7-12). Upon enrollment at a Regents institution, voucher recipients are given priority in the awarding of funds under the IMAGES program.

College Bound/IMAGES Vouchers (Table E2) - In 2020-2021, a total of 830 Iowa resident minority students in grades 7-12 participated in a College Bound/IMAGES voucher activity through the University of Iowa or through a program jointly sponsored with Iowa State University and the University of Northern Iowa. Of these participants, 817 identified as racial/ethnic minority students. A College Bound voucher was sent to each qualified student.

College Bound Admissions and Enrollment (Table 1) – This table notes the number of entering lowa resident freshmen (1st year) and undergraduate new transfer students who applied, were admitted, and enrolled for the fall 2020 term at the University of Iowa. A total of 6,748 applications from Iowa resident freshmen and new transfer students were received, including 1,448 from minority students. A total of 3,332 Iowa resident students matriculated (net enrollment), of which 622 were minority students.

IMAGES AWARDS

IMAGES awards of up to a maximum of \$3,500 per year are made to lowa resident minority students who demonstrate financial need. IMAGES awards may be received for up to eight semesters and students must be making satisfactory academic progress toward their degrees.

Total Award Numbers and Dollars (Table A) - At the University of Iowa, a total of 225 Iowa resident minority undergraduate students received IMAGES grant awards for the 2020-21 academic year. These students received a total of \$630,267.

Awards to College Bound/IMAGES Voucher Recipients - Of the 225 students receiving an IMAGES award, 129 are College Bound/IMAGES voucher recipients receiving \$363,239.

The University of Iowa initiated the Advantage Iowa (AI) Program in 2007-08. Al was designed to enhance recruitment and retention outcomes for all SUI underrepresented students and/or students involved in Upward Bound programs. University funds previously allocated to provide added financial support beyond the required \$630,000 IMAGES annual budget are now used to fund this critical AI initiative. Total support of \$1,873,487 for underrepresented Iowa residents includes \$630,267 IMAGES and \$1,243,220 Advantage Iowa.

APPENDIX - COLLEGE BOUND ACTIVITIES

BACKGROUND

Reporting to the Executive Officer & Associate Vice President for Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion, the Center for Diversity and Enrichment (CDE) within the Division of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion brings together under one umbrella a variety of programs and services that help create a welcoming climate for students, staff, and faculty from communities underrepresented in higher education. The Office of Admissions, along with CDE, provides leadership and coordination for K-12 outreach and service to underserved SUI students from diverse backgrounds, including students of color, first-generation students, and students from low-income families. These efforts emphasize focused school and community partner contacts.

CDE is also the home of Upward Bound, a TRIO program funded by the U.S. Department of Education. In existence for 54 years, Upward Bound works extensively with underserved students and families during the academic year to develop leadership skills and college-bound habits and invites them to a residential summer program or summer bridge each summer of their high school year. In 2020-2021, the communities served by Upward Bound were Muscatine, West Liberty, and Columbus Junction.

CAMPUS VISITS

Due to COVID-19 mitigation efforts, in-person recruitment and outreach programs were suspended beginning March 2020 and resumed in June 2021. Showing low attendance and engagement numbers while shifting to virtual programs, the Office of Admissions, Center for Diversity and Enrichment, and campus partners continued adapting events for students to virtually engage with the University of Iowa with increasing engagement through the year. Virtual Hawkeye Visit Days, Iowa Overview sessions, Admission Counselor Appointments, and Hawkeye Hangouts created numerous opportunities for prospective students to meet University of Iowa faculty, staff and students. The Office of Admissions continues to see interest in virtual programs, as well as increased demand for virtual meetings and direct communication.

 College Bound Campus Visits: The Office of Admissions organizes and conducts the Special Group Campus Visit Program that brings minority and first-generation student groups to campus. High school students meet with staff from the Offices of Admissions, Financial Aid, Center for Diversity and Enrichment, Multicultural and International Student Support and Engagement (MISSE) and interact with a student panel. An additional academic component consists of group visits with faculty from various disciplines. Students also receive a campus tour and have the option to eat in one of our dining centers. Several campus visits are

- designed for family participation in order to encourage parents to learn about the University of Iowa. Where appropriate, efforts are made to provide Spanish translation.
- GEAR UP (Gaining Early Awareness and Readiness for Undergraduate Programs): The mission of GEAR UP is to significantly increase the number of students who are prepared to enter and succeed in postsecondary education. Beginning in the 2006-2007 academic year, the University of Iowa began a partnership with seventh graders from middle/high schools throughout Iowa, and this partnership continues today. The university provides campus visit opportunities for students and their families. Campus visits are organized around students' career interests.

GEAR UP received a new seven-year grant, and we work collaboratively to help support their college outreach efforts and bring their students to our campus. The University of Iowa has also been awarded a year-7 GEAR UP subgrant to support the transition of students matriculating to SUI in fall 2020.

Due to COVID-19, the 2020 GEAR UP visit day was cancelled. However, admissions staff spent significant time doing personalized outreach to incoming GEAR UP students.

- College Fairs: The Office of Admissions and the Center for Diversity and Enrichment attended virtual college fairs and diversity recruiting events throughout the state to provide minority students information about the University of Iowa. Students were provided information on admission requirements, scholarships, programs and majors, cost of attendance, campus resources, and what it's like to be a student at the University of Iowa.
- Virtual Diversity Sessions: The Office of Admission offers monthly diversity sessions, in addition to six weekly 30-minute diversity sessions for students and families, to increase the opportunity for students to learn more about diversity, identity-based resources, and inclusive actions at the University of Iowa. A new addition this year included a first-generation resource event, and National Recognition Scholars event, and diversity parent resource night with seven campus departments.

SUMMER PROGRAMS

- Iowa First Nations: In July 2020, 8 Native American high school students from across the states took part in the Iowa First Nations Summer Program. In 2020, Iowa First Nations was a summer virtual program that allowed participants to experience how the university life will look like for them, explore majors, and gain an appreciation for the variety of opportunities on the University of Iowa campus and community, and seeing higher education in general from their perspective. The participants attend structured classroom experiential learning sessions from various campus departments, enjoy hands on classroom experiences, and engaged in a virtual campus tour, while also having the opportunity to get involved in social and recreational activities on campus and in the community. Participants also engage in cultural activities geared towards community and identity building, and also gain knowledge from each other in the process..
- **Upward Bound**: The University of Iowa Upward Bound Project held a six-week virtual summer program for 48 high school students from West Liberty, Columbus Community, and Muscatine High Schools. There were 26 rising students placed in enrichment classes to delve into subjects with detail greater than what is offered by most public schools. 22 senior students

that recently graduated from high school were enrolled in a University of Iowa bridge course that could be later transferred to their institution of choice. 29 students participated in a work-study/career internship where they learned to use a career assessment, research the specifics of a career, conduct informational interviews of professionals, and present their findings.

OFF-CAMPUS PROGRAMS

Co-sponsored Programs:

- The Annual Latinx Youth Summit: "Strengthening and Valuing Latinx Communities in lowa": This is an annual conference for lowa high school students. The focus is Latinx history, culture, and community concerns. It provides an opportunity to explore the changing demographics and dynamics of the Iowa Latinx community and for participants to engage in cultural exchange and community building. The Summit is also an opportunity for Iowa Latinx high school students to gain essential leadership skills. The 22nd annual Latinx Youth Summit was coordinated and sponsored by the Center for Diversity & Enrichment, however the event did not take place due to external circumstances in 2021. The 2021 Latinx Youth Summit, titled "Quién Soy Yo" will be held November
- The Inaugural Iowa National Summer Transportation Institute: The I-STI is founded on a strong core curriculum that allows high school students, BIPOC students, young women, and youth with and without disabilities to a explore all aspects of the transportation industry and its role in our society through STEM curriculum and educational enhancements. Coordinated with the University of Iowa College of Education, Iowa Department of Transportation, and various community businesses, the inaugural year of the virtual institute brought 12 students together for a 2-week program to understand STWP's role in transportation and promote college readiness. In addition to presentations on Aerospace engineering, rail transportation, river power, research techniques, the National Advanced Driving Simulator, and financial literacy, the Office of Admissions introduced participants to life as a student through a virtual campus tour, an introduction to post-secondary education, and time management college-preparation activities.

OTHER COLLEGE BOUND ACTIVITIES

- Publications: The Office of Admissions and the Center for Diversity and Enrichment publications provide additional resources for individuals interested in the University of Iowa. Some of these updates include the websites (http://diversity.uiowa.edu/cde), (http://admissions.uiowa.edu/diversity) and information sheets on college preparedness and Regents Admissions Standards. Prospective minority students receive the "Opportunity + Community" brochure that highlights current minority student, faculty and staff experiences at the University of Iowa. We also provide Latinx, African American, Asian American, Native American, students with disabilities, and LGBT students with postcards highlighting diversity, academic, and support resources on campus specific to their identities.
- **Electronic Communications:** Multiple emails are sent to pre-college students from both the Center for Diversity and Enrichment and Enrollment Services in the spring that focus on campus diversity resources, information about student life, FAFSA completion, housing application submission deadlines, admission acceptance processes, applying for scholarships, and encouraging campus visits.

College Bound/IMAGES Report 2020-2021 Academic Year

2020-2021 College Bound Annual Report Iowa State University

A total of 281 students attended a College Bound-sponsored event during the 2020-21 academic year. Vouchers or certificates of participation were mailed to 59 students whose ethnic status is confirmed as African American, American Indian/Alaska Native, Asian, Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander, Hispanic/Latino/a, or two or more races.

The Iowa State University College Bound Program continued to work with the University of Iowa and the University of Northern Iowa on sponsoring some of the larger college bound events. However, several Iowa State College Bound events were sponsored independently of the other Regent institutions.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic several events and programs, including Iowa State University's Multicultural Student Visit Day, were cancelled or held at a significantly reduced capacity. Numerous other events were held virtually. Dependent upon place-in-time circumstances surrounding the COVID-19 pandemic some events continued in person. In multiple virtual and inperson events, family members were encouraged to attend alongside their student. Several of lowa State's College Bound events, including Science Bound Countdown to College workshops, offered parent sessions in addition to student sessions. Additionally, family members were encouraged to attend sessions focusing on how to prepare for Iowa's public universities' admissions requirements.

Summary of Activities by Program and Ethnicity

A total of 59 College Bound program vouchers (certificates of participation) were distributed to confirmed American ethnic minority students.

Outreach & Campus Visit Summary

The common goal of each program is to prepare multicultural students for college admission, inform them of their college options, and assist them with application processes and financial aid. This is a list of programs that took place during the 2020-2021 academic year with a summary of activities by grade and followed by ethnic code.

Campus & Group Visits

With the global COVID-19 pandemic spanning the 2020-2021 school year, campus and group visits were both creatively and cautiously modeled to offer virtual visits and reduced capacity inperson visits when appropriate. Despite the modified structure of campus and group visits several schools and agencies were contacted and encouraged to schedule a visit to Iowa State University. Visits were coordinated with the Offices of Admissions, Multicultural Student Affairs, Student Financial Aid, Student Support Services, and various academic departments and student organizations. In accordance with the style of campus and/or group visit students interacted either in-person or virtually with college student mentors and staff. In 2020-2021, the Iowa State College Bound program hosted Jesup High School, Hillcrest High School, Ottumwa High School, Central College Upward Bound ETS, Colfax-Mingo High School, University of NE – Lincoln ETS, iJAG Ottumwa, Creighton TRiO (Bryan HS, Benson HS, Omaha Central HS, Omaha North HS, Omaha South HS, Bellevue East HS, Burke HS, Davis HS, Lewis & Clark HS), Iowa Lakes TRiO (Spencer HS, Emmetsburg HS, Estherville HS), UNI TRiO (Waterloo East & West HS – these students are removed from this report as they also attended another College Bound event), and Evanston Township.

Early Outreach Program (EOP) @ ISU

Unfortunately, due to the continued global COVID-19 pandemic this College Bound event for high school students was not rescheduled during the 2020-2021 academic year.

Multicultural Student Experience Day

Operating under cautious measures and in accordance with point-in-time COVID-19 procedures, the Multicultural tudent Experience Day for the 2020-2021 academic school year was cancelled. In the past this program has been a day-long program held in the fall semester designed to give multicultural students and their families a chance to learn about the opportunities and services available on campus. It traditionally includes information about scholarships, student organizations, internships, and the admission process. Formerly, the program featured a Multicultural Student Affairs information session as well as session during which students could meet the Multicultural Liaison Officer within their undergraduate college. Additionally, students and families had the opportunity to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on site with the assistance of staff from the Office of Student Financial Aid. Students who normally would have attended this event were encouraged to attend other College Bound events that were offered virtually.

Virtual Latino Family Visit Day

Creatively rethinking the traditional Latino Family Visit Day that is hosted by the Office of Admissions in partnership with the brothers of Lambda Theta Phi Latin Fraternity, Inc., several virtual Latino Family visit day options were offered. These virtual sessions aimed to align with the needs of our Spanish-speaking students/families. Offered on multiple dates, students can hear a presentation on Admission requirements and Financial Aid and be connected with a variety of resources. The virtual events, both live and recorded, were hosted on the following dates:

- November 7, 2020 Live two-hour event modeled after the traditional Latino Family Visit Day
- March 3, 2021 Live event focused on Admissions and Financial Aid information
- March 11, 2021 Recorded presentation of the March 3, 2021 live event
- March 17, 2021 Live event focused on Academic Success with a faculty panel
- March 25, 2021 Recorded presentation of the March 17, 2021 live event
- March 31, 2021 Live event focused on Multicultural Student Success
- April 8, 2021 Recorded presentation of the March 31, 2021 live event
- April 17, 2021 Live event focused on Q&A with a Multicultural Student Panel

In additional to the Virtual Latino Family Visit Days, the Office of Admissions also hosted Spanish Virtual Visits. During these visits the campus visit presentation was presented entirely in Spanish. Students also had opportunity to virtually interact with a Spanish-speaking student panel. Unfortunately, the attendance of these events was not tracked and thus not formally included in the counts present in this report.

GEAR UP Iowa Visit Day

lowa High Schools taking part in the GEAR UP lowa program had 11th and 12th grade students register individually for virtual visits. GEAR UP lowa Visit Day is intended for students taking part

in the GEAR UP lowa program. The virtual revision of this traditionally in-person, on-campus event allowed students to take a virtual tour of campus.

Multicultural Vision Program

The Multicultural Vision Program (MVP) was created to provide up to 100 in-state multicultural students with demonstrated need, the opportunity to receive a renewable tuition grant provided they demonstrate potential in ways that go beyond class ranking or test scores. The program targets 100 students to receive the grant. Students are encouraged to attend on-campus and virtual programs to learn more about the application process. Candidates and their families have the opportunity to visit with Iowa State staff regarding their options at Iowa State University through MVP.

Outreach Events

These traditionally off-campus events were offered virtually during the 2020-2021 academic year and/or cancelled due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. These events aim to provide prospective students an opportunity to discuss college admission requirements, scholarships, and academic life. Speakers and college representatives were available to counsel students and families about the college selection process. College Bound co-sponsors these events.

I'll Make Me A World in Iowa (IMMAWII)

IMMAWII is a diverse collaboration of Iowans, which highlights African American arts, culture and contributions through education, awareness and preservation during an annual enrichment celebration and with continual educational outreach. Unfortunately, this event was cancelled during the 2020-2021 academic year due to COVID-19. Formerly, the Iowa State College Bound Program co-sponsors and contributes to Education Day by providing sessions on college preparation, assists in facilitating the Black History Game Show and collaborating with faculty to present educational sessions for middle and high school students, teachers and families. Iowa State looks forward to this event returning post-pandemic.

Science Bound Program, Countdown 2 College

Science Bound is Iowa State University's premier pre-college through college program to empower Iowa students of color to pursue degrees and careers in agriculture, science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (ASTEM) fields and education. In partnership with four Iowa school districts and Iowa State University, SCIENCE BOUND engages middle and high school students and families from Denison, Des Moines, Marshalltown, and Osceola (Clarke County), Iowa. Science Bound collaborates with Admissions to facilitate the Countdown 2 College program for its 12th grade students in each of the districts. Through workshops focused on applying for college, filing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), financing college, housing and meal plans, student services, and academic support, both students and parents/guardians are guided through the requisite steps of, and thoroughly informed about, the college-going process.

Multicultural Vision Program

The Multicultural Vision Program (MVP) Award grants a full-tuition award to incoming first-year students, who are U.S. Citizens or permanent residents, residents of the state of Iowa and identify as: American Indian or Alaskan Native, African American, Asian, Pacific Islander, Desi American, Hispanic or Latino/a/x, or Multi-Racial on the application for undergraduate admission; or who have participated in a federally funded Educational Talent Search or Upward Bound program. Students will also demonstrate academic potential in ways that go beyond class ranking or test scores.

The program goal is to award 100 students with the grant. The Multicultural Vision Program aims to enhance the ISU undergraduate experience by preparing students with the tools to be an agent of change in their community. It will also help them grow as a person by expanding their cultural awareness, building supportive relationships, and achieving academic success. The program is guided by five principles: Sense of Belonging, Social Involvement, Academic Success, Leadership Development and Community Engagement.

Students are encouraged to visit campus, attend outreach programs, and at times participate in an interview to enhance their chances of being selected. Numerous events that were traditionally offered in-person were translated to virtual events due to the global COVID-19 pandemic. Iowa State staff visit with candidates and their families regarding their options at Iowa State University through the Multicultural Vision Program. The students who applied for the MVP award were not accounted for in the total number of students who participated in college bound activities.

A total of 164 new MVP appicants enrolled at Iowa State University for the Fall 2021 semester. These award recipients participated in a University Studies orientation course during the Fall 2021 semester and in other programs and activities, including events for parents and families, throughout their enrollment. This table represents the students that participated in the MVP awarding process. Not all have applied for admission, received the grant, nor enrolled at Iowa State University.

In fall 2021, there were 262 MVP applications submitted. There was a total of 242 completed applications and 164 students enrolled who were MVP applicants. While 164 students applied for MVP and enrolled not all enrolled with the award. They may have qualified for other scholarships and/or did not have the need.
