

2021 Building Energy Management Program and Iowa Energy Bank Annual Report

Executive Summary

The Iowa Economic Development Authority (IEDA) established the Building Energy Management Program and the Energy Loan Program pursuant to Iowa Code sections 473.19 and 473.20. Through the Iowa Energy Bank, which has been administered by the State Energy Office housed at the IEDA since the 2014 program year, the authority has provided assistance to the state, state agencies, political subdivisions, school districts, area education agencies, community colleges, and nonprofit organizations implement energy management improvements to reduce energy consumption and energy costs.

In accordance with Iowa Code section 473.19, IEDA respectfully submits the 2021 Building Energy Management Program and Iowa Energy Bank Annual Report. The results outlined in this report reflect the time frame January 2021 to January 2022.

Loan Summary

No new loans have been issued since 2014 and loans previously issued are in the repayment phase.
