IOWA COLLEGE STUDENT AID COMMISSION Health Care Loan Repayment Program Annual Report – FY 2022

lowa Code, section 261.116, requires that the lowa College Student Aid Commission submit an annual report on the Health Care Loan Repayment Program as follows:

261.116

7. The commission shall submit in a report to the general assembly by January 1, annually, the number of individuals who received loan repayment pursuant to this section, where the participants practiced or taught, the amount paid to each program participant, and other information identified by the commission as indicators of outcomes from the program.

The Health Care Loan Repayment Program provides federal student loan repayment assistance to eligible registered nurses, advanced registered nurse practitioners, and physician assistants working full-time in an eligible service commitment area in lowa, and to nurse educators teaching full-time at an eligible college/university in lowa. The maximum loan repayment amount is the lesser of \$6,000 or 20 percent of a borrower's total federal student loan balance. Individuals can receive assistance for up to five consecutive years.

A total of 54 applicants received loan repayments totaling \$246,014 in FY 2022, consisting of 13 registered nurses, 17 advanced registered nurse practitioners, 8 physician assistants, and 16 nurse educators. The average loan repayment award was \$4,556.
